

DRESS CODE

for dining



We advise all Members and their accompanied dining guests, to take note of the dress code that is associated with the restaurant they choose to dine in. Below are examples of the dress code for each dining outlet, if there is any doubt, please contact the Main Reception who can advise on 02 673 1111.

casual

A casual dress code applies.

Outlet:

Zest, The Pool Café, Sports Lounge, The Shore, The Family Hub, Waves and The Wharf

Examples of Permitted:

National dress, t-shirts, jeans, shorts, vest tops (women) and all footwear.

Examples of Not Permitted:

Swimwear, hot pants, vest tops (men), apparel with offensive images or words.



smart casual

A smart, casual and modest dress code applies.

Outlet:

The Club Bar and Al Sarab (includes The Vista and The Restaurant before 17:00)

Examples of Permitted:

National dress, jeans, tailored dress shorts, polo shirts, t-shirts, short-sleeved collared shirts, sports shoes, closed shoes, open heels.

Examples of Not Permitted:

Swimwear, sports shorts, sportswear, hot pants, vest tops (men), apparel with offensive images or words, casual beach footwear, such as flip flops.

smart

A smart and modest dress code applies.

Outlet:

The Vista and The Restaurant (from 17:00)

Examples of Permitted:

National dress, collared shirts (short and long-sleeved), polo shirt, full-length trousers, tailored dress shorts (until 20:30). Closed shoes and open heels.

Examples of Not Permitted:

Swimwear, shorts, ripped jeans, sportswear, hot pants, t-shirts (unless with jacket), vest tops (men), apparel with offensive images or words, sports shoes, casual beach footwear, such as flip flops.
